

Electoral Board Meeting

September 11, 2017

Attendees: Rene Dolly, Halle Cullison, Gloria Basye, Tommy Newman, and Lori Webb

The meeting convened and Halle began by appraising the board of all tasks completed in preparation for the November election. Thus far Halle is several weeks ahead of schedule for the necessary tasks. The only tasks yet to be completed are:

1. L&A (logistics and analysis) testing
2. Selecting the officers of election
3. Training for officers of election
4. Dates for training and testing.

We agreed on L&A testing on September 27th at 9:30. Training dates for the officers of election are set for October 19th at 10am and another scheduled October 30th at 10am, both to be held in the courthouse conference room.

Absentee voting begins October 06th.

Halle will send letters next week to the officers of election forewarning them about the October training dates.

Halle sees no reason why she will not be present for the election. We have decided that Halle will train me (Lori Webb) on how to use Veris and how to complete the election reports on the days the election officers receive their training.

The electoral board members signed the agreed upon Richmond County Registrar's Office Employee Handbook. A copy will be put in the electoral board minute book and the original will be kept on Halle's desk.

Ballots should arrive in the next two or three weeks.
