

Unofficial Electoral Board Meeting @ 1100

Halle:

1. We got a grant for \$49000 for the Registrar's office that has to be used for the November election.
 1. Electronic poll books
 1. Apple model like Northumberland has
2. Additional staffing starting in August because of the no excuse absentee voting.
3. Currently doing change of address forms for voters to verify their information or if they had poll book issues at the last election.
4. We need officers of election... November may be worse than the primary we just had.
5. Vote by mail campaign for November to let people know they have that option.
6. Nov 3 is the Election Day because the Governor can not move it.
7. Support staff from Hart on Election Day has been priced. Looking into spitting the cost with Northumberland. And looking into Hart doing the L&A testing for the November election. The cost for both services would be \$3,570 per locality.
8. County is putting a counter in the registrar's office using Covid19 funds provided to the county.
9. The 2017 book changed the residency rules to living in an adjoining county.
10. Potential drive through voting in November if we get enough election officials to volunteer.
11. Halle asked Rene about the complaints received about the Farnham election officials being rude to voters.
 1. Rene said she didn't think they were rude.
12. We should get the ADA compliance list and have Morgan and Motley to see if the Julia G Paige center meets the requirements.
13. Perhaps we could use the high school again.

William:

1. When does everyone else's term end?
2. Has been reading the code book and has questions.
 1. Supposed to meet the first week in February... and March at a time set by the board.
 2. The book says to post minutes to meeting and post them, but we don't post them.
 3. The 2016 book says you have to be a resident of the county.
